

User Manual for the Small All Comfort Changing Pad

Manufactured in Poland.

This document is the complete user and setup manual for the Small All infant changing pad. It contains key information for parents and caregivers to enable safe, correct setup, use, and maintenance of the product.

The Small All pad was developed with your baby's comfort and safety in mind, providing a comfortable and stable space for changing. Inside you'll find step- by- step guidance for preparing the pad for use, important safety warnings, and recommendations for cleaning and care.

1. PRODUCT DESCRIPTION

The infant changing pad is made of child- safe integral- skin polyurethane foam and certified pine plywood. These materials are durable, easy to keep clean, and gentle on a baby's delicate skin.

2. SAFE USE GUIDELINES

□ Never leave a child unattended—even for a moment.
□ Do not use in a cot/crib; the pad is not a sleeping surface.
□ Always place the pad on a stable, flat, and dry surface—minimum 800 × 500 mm.
☐ Ensure the surface is non- slip and free of irregularities.
☐ Inspect the product regularly—stop using if any damage is present.
☐ Do not carry the pad with the child on it.
☐ Keep away from open flames and heat sources.
☐ The pad is intended for changing children up to 11 kg and up to 12 months of age.
$\hfill \Box$ CAUTION – slip hazard: use only on a stable, non- slip surface; an anti- slip mat underneath is
recommended.
☐ Use away from furniture edges and stairs—fall hazard.
□ Do not use on appliances that may vibrate/move (e.g., washing machine, tumble dryer).

3. CLEANING AND MAINTENANCE

Wipe the surface with a soft, damp cloth. If needed, use mild soap. Do not use corrosive agents or solvents. Dry thoroughly before use. Do not immerse the pad in water.

4. SURFACE DISINFECTION

Disinfect the surface with 60–70% ethyl or isopropyl alcohol (spray or wipe). A short contact time (30–60 s) is sufficient; afterwards, wipe with a clean, damp cloth. Note: prolonged soaking can damage the pad's surface.

5. STORAGE

Store in a cool, dry place away from heat sources and sunlight. Do not place heavy items on the pad. Store horizontally or vertically without bending.

7. ADDITIONAL SAFETY RECOMMENDATIONS

Make sure all care accessories (e.g., diapers, cosmetics) are within reach. Always check the stability of the place where the pad is set. Ensure the pad cannot slip, fall, or tip over. Clean and inspect the surface regularly. If visible damage is present (tears, cracks, deformation, breakage, detachment), stop using and replace the product. Do not use if any components of the changing pad are loose or unstable.

8. DISPOSAL

At end of life, dispose of the product at an appropriate waste collection point in accordance with local regulations.

9. LEGAL INFORMATION AND COMPLIANCE

The product is not subject to CE marking. Safety has been ensured in accordance with Regulation (EU) 2023/988 (GPSR) through the manufacturer's risk assessment, mechanical testing with reference to EN 12221 (standard applied voluntarily), and control of material composition.



10. REACH - SUBSTANCE RESTRICTIONS (testing status)

The manufacturer selects materials with regard to REACH restrictions (EC 1907/2006), Annex XVII.

Phthalates (entry 51): determination of DEHP, DBP, BBP, DIBP by GC- MS has been commissioned for all color variants; the report will be included in the technical documentation upon receipt.

Other entries (where applicable to materials used): PAH – entry 50, lead – entry 63, formaldehyde – entry 77 (from 06.08.2026) are under material surveillance and will be confirmed by testing if relevant to the components used.

Note: material suppliers' declarations are archived and available to the competent authorities.

11. PRODUCT MARKING AND IDENTIFICATION

Full markings (manufacturer's name and address, electronic address, Model/SKU, batch/lot number, key pictograms/warnings) are placed on the product and on the packaging (carton). The manufacturer's contact details are also included in this Manual.

Fall hazard: Never leave your child unattended. To avoid death or serious injury, always keep your child within arm's reach. Place the changing pad on a flat, stable surface with minimum dimensions of 800 × 500 mm to ensure maximum safety.
